month in 2010. No  
commercial or  
industrial materials  
will be accepted.

In the mean time, save the Township money and yourself time and bring your paint, batteries, fluorescent bulbs to Rona, Home Depot and Home Hardware (see Twp website for details).

## What to bring?

- ✓ **Paint** (4L or 20L cans, **EMPTY** cans go in scrap steel pile)
  - ✓ **Gasoline** (small amounts IN CONTAINERS)
  - ✓ **Aerosols** (empty cans can go in household garbage)
  - ✓ **Batteries**
  - ✓ **Propane tanks** (11lb single use **ONLY**)
  - ✓ **Pesticides/Fertilizers**
  - ✓ **Household cleaners**
  - ✓ **Spent Fire Extinguishers**
  - ✓ **Oil** (**MUST** be in container!)
  - ✓ **Pharmaceuticals** (pills, medicine, etc., **NO sharps**)
  - ✓ **Fluorescent Tubes** (**NO ballasts**)
  - ✓ **Compact Fluorescents**
- IF AN ITEM IS NOT ON THE LIST, DON'T BRING IT! IT WON'T BE ACCEPTED!**

## What NOT to bring?

- × Sharps/Pathological Waste - *call a local pharmacy*
- × Radioactive Waste
- × Lighting Ballasts
- × PCB's
- × Explosives (including flares) - *call OPP*
- × Propane tanks (20lb) - *take to Elgin Equipment Rentals*
- × Empty paint cans - *scrap metal*
- × Garbage

**These items will absolutely NOT be accepted, so don't bring them! Dispose of them appropriately or call the manufacturer for assistance.**

**Bring a piece of ID with your address on it when you come as you MUST be a resident of Rideau Lakes or Westport to participate!**

- Tax bill \*
- \* Hydro, gas, propane, oil bill \* Phone, satellite, internet, cable bill \*
